

## **FAIRSHARE FUNDRAISING GUIDELINES**

The fairshare fund-raising opportunities provided by the BCHS Band boosters are a vital and important part of our organization. They allow many students the opportunity to participate in the band program. Many families take advantage of these opportunities for many different reasons – some to supplement their fairshare payments and others to completely pay for their payments.

The Boosters try to offer as many opportunities throughout the year as possible. The majority of our opportunities involve working for various organizations for compensation, i.e. Kentucky Speedway, and Reds games, Turfway Park's "The Lane's End Stakes".

In the past the BCHS Band Boosters has enjoyed an excellent reputation with many of these organizations for providing the number of workers needed and also for the quality of the manpower provided. This past year we have had some concerns in these two areas.

In order to protect our opportunities to fund-raise with these organizations, we have instituted Fairshare Fund-raising Guidelines. They consist of overall guidelines voted upon by the boosters and specific guidelines inherent to the individual opportunities offered at the various organizations based upon the policies of those organizations. The specific guidelines will be handled by each chairperson(s) for each fund-raising opportunity.

These guidelines would serve to protect our future opportunities by allowing everyone to know what is expected of them from the beginning. Thus, allowing them to make an informed decision on whether or not to participate in these voluntary fairshare fund-raising opportunities.
