

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- _____ I understand that I am a representative of both Boone County High School and the BCHS Band Boosters. As such, I agree to follow the guidelines for the fund-raising opportunities in which I choose to participate.
- _____ I understand that should I agree to participate in a fund-raising opportunity, I am committing to work at that event. If I do not work at that event and do not have a valid reason, I understand that I will be placed on an “As Needed” list for future fairshare fund-raising events for a period of one year. “As Needed” means that I will not be guaranteed to work in a fund-raising opportunity, but will be called if a need arises.
- _____ I understand that if an organization the BCHS Band Boosters has contracted to work for is not pleased with my performance, I will not be asked to return to the event.
- _____ I understand that I can not use my fairshare funds to purchase fairshare fundraising products.
- _____ I understand that I must complete any required annual training before I can be considered to work a fund-raising event. I understand failing to complete required training can result in incorrect payment to me.

FAIRSHARE GUIDELINES - KENTUCKY SPEEDWAY – DJ

I, _____, agree to abide by the following guidelines:

I understand the uniform required for Kentucky Speedway/DJ will consist of the following:

- ✓ Black, Blue or Tan (pant or shorts) consisting of “Docker-Type” material falling no shorter than 5” above the knee. No jeans of any kind.
- ✓ Closed-toed, closed-heel shoes.
- ✓ A Plain White Collar shirt.
- ✓ Hair longer than shoulder length must be pulled back.
- ✓ Socks are to be worn at all times.
- ✓ My hat or sun visor will be provided by DJ and will cost \$4. This is to be deducted from my fairshare account. Replacement hats will cost \$4.
- ✓ Hats are to be brim forward.
- ✓ Lightly applied makeup only.
- ✓ Nails are to be no longer than 3 cm and only clear polish is allowed.
- ✓ Sunglasses are permitted in designated stands only.
- ✓ Badges and aprons will be provided by DJ and must be worn at all times. They are to be returned at the end of each shift. Failing to return items, may result in charges that will be deducted from my fairshare account.

Cell phones are to be turned off or on silent during working hours. Emergency calls must be placed out of sight of the customers.

Reporting to work under the influence of, the use and/or possession of alcoholic beverages or non-prescription drugs, or use of foul language by all workers in the stadium will result in immediate dismissal.

I must enter the stadium through the employee area only. I will also park in the employee parking area (Lot J).

Kentucky Speedway, DJ and BCHS Band Boosters are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Breaks are to be taken before the race begins or with the approval of your stand leader. I will not eat in the area I’m assigned or by another DJ’s stand. I will take my break out of sight of the customers.

_____ I understand there is a limit of 2 alcoholic beverages per person with a valid ID. Serving more than 2 can result in Kentucky Speedway and/or DJ removing me from the stadium immediately and not being able to return for any future events.

_____ I will remain at Kentucky Speedway and will leave only after my stand leader has cleared me to leave.

_____ Stand leaders will give consideration to your job preferences but you agree to work in the position in which you are needed.

_____ I understand that I will sign in and out on the designed paperwork and time sheet. I understand failing to do so can result in incorrect payment to me.

_____ I am under the age of 18 and my birthday is _____.

_____ I understand that if I'm under the age 18 that I must be a member of the Boone County High School Band.

_____ *I prefer not to participate in the selling of Alcohol.*
